UNIT 97 Relative adverbs | *where, when, why; which, what, all that* in relative clauses

A

To talk about places in a relative clause, we usually use the adverb *where*, which can be substituted by the expressions *in which* / *at which*...

The town where I was born is in the north of Belgium. (also: The town in which I was born...)

This is the hotel where / in which we spent our honeymoon.

B

To talk about a period of time, we usually use the adverb *when*, which can substitute *in which* / *on which* / *at which*...

Halloween is the festival when children play 'trick or treat'.

With the expressions *the year...*, *the day...*, *the time...*, you can find both *when* and *that* or no adverb at all.

This is the time (when) we usually meet.

The year (that) they got married was 1992, I think.

C

To talk about the reason for something happening, we usually use *the reason why...* or even just *the reason...*, instead of *the reason for which*.

I don't know the reason why she left.

The reason I went to the party was that I wanted to meet Marion.

BY car // ON foot

It takes 20 years to learn English.

It takes **them** 2 semesters to learn English.

How long does it take you to get to work by bicycle?

It takes me half an hour to get to work by bicycle.

It takes Thiago half an hour to get to work by bicycle.

But his sister is very fast, it takes Carlinha 18 minutes to get to work by bicycle.

Carla goes to work by bicycle in 18 minutes.

How far is the park from your home?

It is 1km far from my home.

The park is 1km far from my home.

When you go to the park, to do go by car or on foot? = **How** do you go to the park?

I go to the park on foot.

How long does it take you to get to the park on foot?

It takes her 5 minutes to get to the park running.

It takes me 5 minutes to get to the park running.

Do you go to the park in 5 minutes? = Does she get to the park in 5 minutes?

I get to the park in 5 minutes. = She gets to the park in 5 minutes.

WHEN do you go to the bar?

I go to the bar every other day (one day yes, one day no).

How often do you go to church?

I never go to church.

When do you go to work?

I go to work in the morning.

How often do you go to work?

I go to work everyday.

How does he go to work?

He goes to work by car.

When do you go to church?

When does she go to church?

She goes to church ON Tuesdays.
