Man: Jefferson Drive.

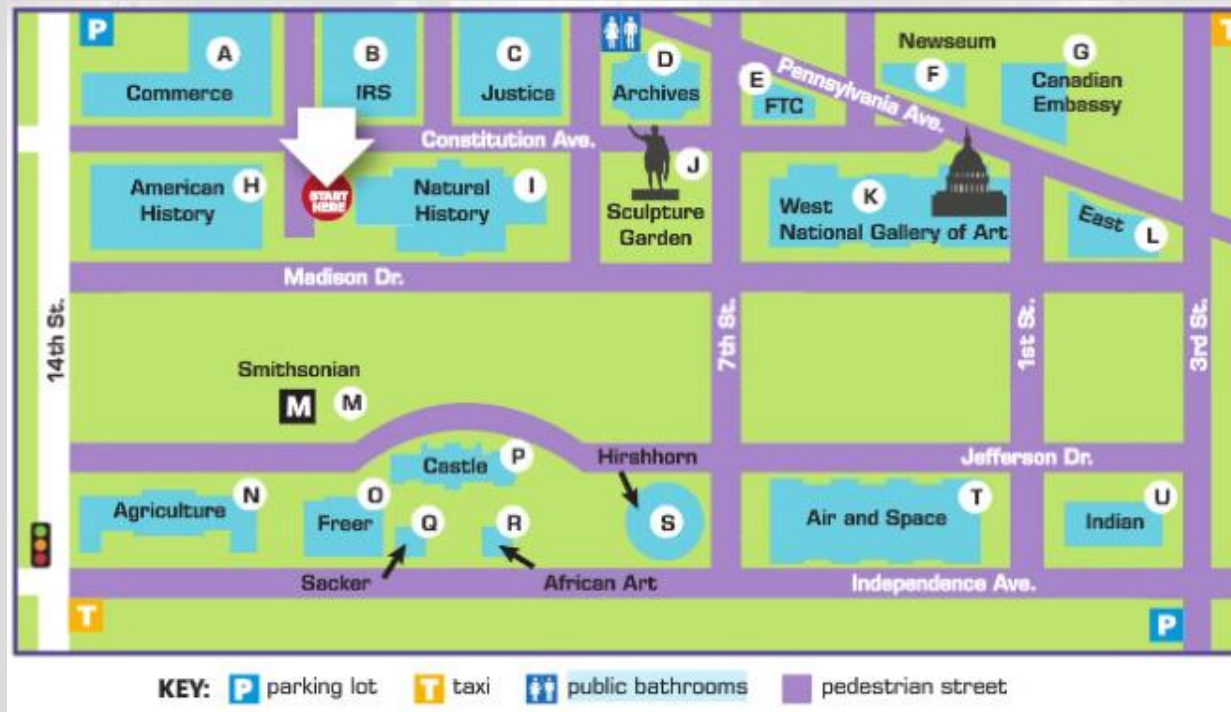
